

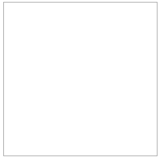

Crassula ovata

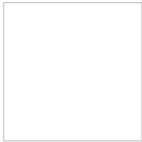
succulent shrub; green glossy foliage; small white flowers; garden or pot

Yucca (elephantipes) gigantea 'Variegata'

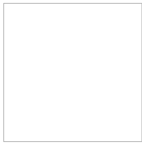
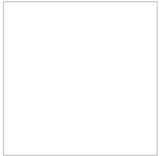
Tall; multi-branched succulent with striped leaves; very hardy
WATERING > 1 Drop // HEIGHT > 0 – 1.5 meters

Beaucarnea guatemalensis

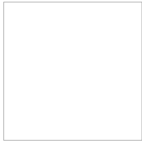
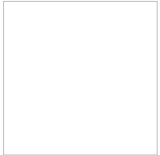
architectural palm-like succulent; swollen base; white flower spikes
WATERING > 1.5 Drops // HEIGHT > < 10 meters



Grass Tree

Xanthorrhoea latifolia subsp. latifolia

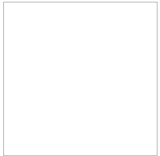
grass-like foliage atop black trunks; slow growing; cream flower spike
WATERING > 2 Drops // HEIGHT > 1.5 – 3 meters



Flame Tree

Brachychiton acerifolius

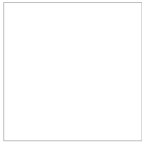
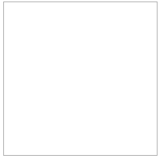
tree with shiny maple-like leaves; deciduous; showy red flowers summer
WATERING > 2 Drops // HEIGHT > > 10 meters



Yellow Latan Palm

Latania verscaffeltii

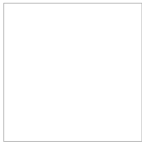
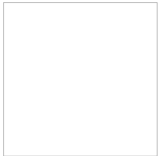
medium fan palm with large leaves; red when young

Empress of Brazil (Bromeliad)

Alcantarea imperialis

striking architectural plant for garden or pots
WATERING > 2.5 Drops // HEIGHT > 0 – 1.5 meters



Pitcairnia (Bromeliad)

Pitcairnia wendlandii

architectural plant for garden or pots; red flower spike
WATERING > 2.5 Drops // HEIGHT > 0 – 1.5 meters
