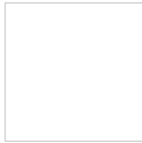
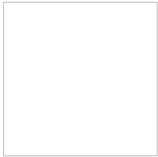


Queensland Bottle Tree

WATERING > 1 Drop // HEIGHT > < 10 meters

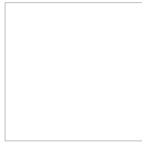


Little Kurrajong

Brachychiton bidwillii

small tree; deciduous; showy red flowers in winter/spring

WATERING > 1.5 Drops // HEIGHT > < 10 meters



Summer Red; Summer Beauty Corymbia

Corymbia 'Summer Red', C. 'Summer Beauty'

small tree; green leaves; showy red or pink flowers

WATERING > 1.5 Drops // HEIGHT > < 10 meters

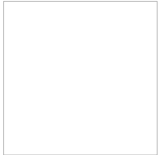


Weeping Bottlebrush

Melaleuca (Callistemon) viminalis

tree with weeping form; red bottlebrush flowers; wildlife attracting

WATERING > 1.5 Drops // HEIGHT > > 10 meters

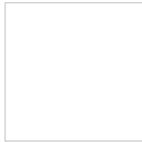


Coconut Ice Grevillea

Grevillea 'Coconut Ice'

large shrub with /green foliage; dark pink flowers

WATERING > 2 Drops // HEIGHT > 1.5 – 3 meters



Honey Gem

Grevillea 'Honey Gem'

large shrub with fine leaved foliage; masses of golden flowers

WATERING > 2 Drops // HEIGHT > < 10 meters



Ivory Curl Flower

Buckinghamia celsissima

tree; dark green/grey leaves; masses of cream flowers in summer

WATERING > 2 Drops // HEIGHT > < 10 meters
