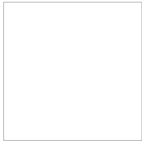
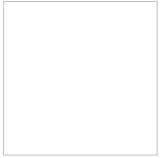


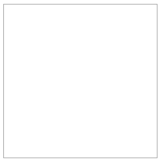

Adenium obesum

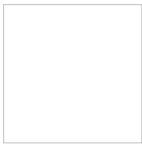
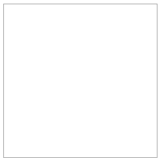
succulent with swollen base; large brightly coloured flowers; garden or pot

Lagerstroemia archeriana

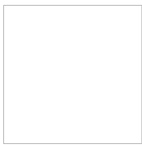
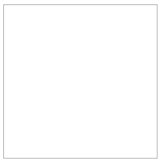
tree with lilac flowers and persistent seed capsules

Aechmea recurvata benrathii

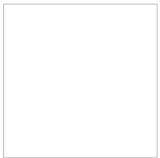
striking architectural plant for garden or pots

Xanthostemon chrysanthus 'Expo Gold'

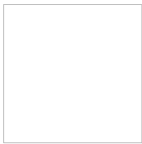
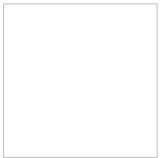
small, slowly growing shrub; masses of yellow flowers in summer

WATERING > 2.5 Drops // HEIGHT > 1.5 – 3 meters



Dyckia (Bromeliad)

Dyckia marnie-lapostollei

small succulent; silver/grey leaves with thorny margins
WATERING > 1 Drop // HEIGHT > 0 – 1.5 meters
